You can set up Wi-fi access for your laptop and other mobile devices.

The wireless network - called eduroam - is available at all of our Australian campuses.

To connect, select SwinburneConnect from your wi-fi network settings on your device. Then, open your browser and type in the address of any website such as google.com.

You'll be automatically redirected to a Swinburne webpage where you can configure your device for eduroam.

Accept the end user agreement and then follow the prompts to install the wireless network profile.

Your SIMS username and password will be required.

Once the eduroam profile is installed you will be able to access the network by selecting eduroam in your devices settings.

Eduroam is available at other universities which means that if you visit a campus of another university you should be able to access free wi-fi.
