VOICEOVER: In this video we will show you how to accept or defer your offer if you are a domestic student.

If you are an international student, you would have accepted your offer by submitting your formal acceptance documentation. You don't need to do anything here.

Similarly, if you are PhD or Masters by Research students, please follow the acceptance instructions outlined in your offer letter.

Once you have logged in to My Swinburne, this is your home page.

[My Applications tile is highlighted]

This is the My Application tile.

To begin, click on the course that you wish to accept the offer for.

Before you accept your offer, you can check the details on this page.

Here you can see the course name **[course name is highlighted in the top left]**, details of the year **[study period details are highlighted in the centre of the screen]** and study period you will commence your course once accepted.

To accept your offer, click the Accept button at the top left corner of the screen **[Red 'Accept' button in the top left corner is highlighted and clicked. A pop-up Confirm Action box appears. Click okay to confirm your selection. **[OK button is clicked]**

Now that you've accepted your offer, you have completed the admission part of the process.

You are now ready to undertake the next step of your enrolment activities.

If your circumstances have changed and you can no longer commence when you expected to, you can defer your offer.

To defer your offer, click on the application that you wish to defer.
